FRIDAY, 20th DECEMBER 2024 -

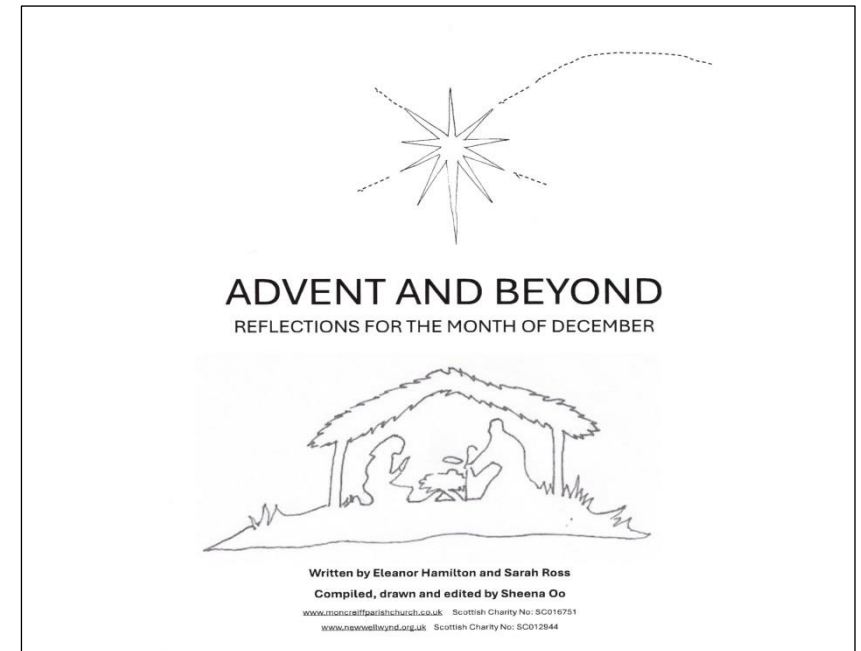
- There are no Friday activities this week.
