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Jeanette completed her probation at New Kilpatrick Parish Church, Bearsden and was Ordained to the Ministry of Word and Sacrament within the Church of Scotland in October 2020. Since that time, Jeanette has been a Healthcare Chaplain with NHS Greater Glasgow and Clyde, based at Inverclyde Royal Hospital. Jeanette is a member of St. John's Parish Church, Gourock and the Presbytery of Clyde.

During her ministry studies, Jeanette was a Parish Assistant in three different parishes across two presbyteries and a part-time Prison Chaplain at HMP Dumfries.

Prior to studying for the ministry, Jeanette was a Police Constable with Dumfries and Galloway Constabulary (March 1990 – April 2000), then a Primary Teacher with Dumfries and Galloway Council (August 2005 – May 2015).

Jeanette holds a number of academic qualifications:

- Bachelor of Arts (majoring in human resources management), University of Paisley;
- Bachelor of Arts (Hons) (Business management), Northumbria University;
- Bachelor of Divinity (Hons) (Min), University of Glasgow;
- Master of Theology, University of Aberdeen;

As well as post-graduate certificates relating to primary education and healthcare chaplaincy.

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PROCEDURE FOR VOTING

- During the singing of the Doxology, the Bible will be removed from the Sanctuary;
- The Rev. Jeanette L. Peel will retire to the Vestry;
- The Congregation will sit. Members of the congregation in the Gallery should make their way downstairs and find a seat.
- The voting will take place in the Session Room;
- Stewards will be appointed to control the flow of members from the Sanctuary to the Session Room to vote;
- Please do not move until directed by a Steward.
- Within the Session Room there will be 3 stations –
 - o New Wellwynd (A – L)
 - o New Wellwynd (M – Z & Adherents)
 - o St. Columba's (A – Z & Adherents)

Based on your surname, go to your respective station, register with the teller and receive your ballot paper;
Take your ballot paper to a different table and cast your vote - FOR or AGAINST;
Fold your Ballot paper and place in the BALLOT BOX.

- Having voted, either proceed to Large Hall for the Tea Fellowship
- OR**
- If you require to leave because of other arrangements, you can do so.
- If you are not eligible to vote, please proceed to the Tea Fellowship and await the results of the vote.
 - Once all votes have been cast, the tellers will count these in the presence of some members of the Kirk Sessions.
 - Once counted, the Rev. Anne Paton having advised the Nominee, will advise the waiting congregation.
